Invitation to comment on RSPO Annual Surveillance Assessment (ASA-04) of Boustead Plantations Berhad (RSPO Membership No:1-0012-04-000-00), Plantation Management Unit – Boustead Estates Agency Sdn Bhd – Trong Business Unit, Taiping, Perak, Malaysia

Dear Stakeholders,

This is to inform that the above Management Unit under the Parent Company **Boustead Plantations Berhad** with RSPO membership number **1-0012-04-000-00** had appointed Intertek Certification International Sdn Bhd to conduct the ~~Initial Certification/Recertification Audit~~ **Surveillance Audit (ASA-04)** at Boustead Estates Agency Sdn Bhd – Trong Business Unit and its supply base, located at **Taiping, Perak**. The audit will be conducted from **27 – 31 July 2026** against the requirements of:

- Malaysia National Interpretation (MYNI) 2019
- RSPO Principles and Criteria (P&C 2024) & RSPO Certification Systems (CS 2025)

In brief, Boustead Plantations Berhad is one of the most experienced and established upstream oil palm plantation company in Malaysia and a subsidiary of Boustead Holdings Berhad ("BHB"), one of Malaysia's oldest and largest diversified conglomerates. Backed by BHB's presence in the plantations business, they have over 100 years of plantations industry experience and over 50 years of oil palm plantation estate management experience. They own and manage a total of 44 oil palm plantation estates and 10 palm oil mills in Malaysia with 18 plantation estates in Peninsular Malaysia, 20 in Sabah and 6 in Sarawak. Also operate 3 palm oil mills in Peninsular Malaysia, 5 in Sabah and 2 in Sarawak. Their total landbank stands approximately at 98,200 hectares (ha). Out of this total, the area under oil palm cultivation is approximately 73,500 ha comprising of 24,100 ha in Peninsular Malaysia, 39,100 ha in Sabah and 10,300 ha in Sarawak.
